

AIR ATTACHÉ TO USA REMAINS UNHURT IN PLANE CRASH

ISLAMABAD 01 MAY, 2013: PAF announces with great relief that Group Captain Mohammad Hasseb Paracha, Air Attaché to USA, miraculously survived the plane crash while landing at West Virginia (USA) airstrip. The incident occurred on 28 April, 2013 when a private company's Cessna 172 carrying Group Captain Mohammad Hasseb Paracha and Mr. Shujjat Rathore (an envoy of Pakistan Embassy, Washington), could not land properly at the short runway (3000 ft) and crashed. The passengers along with the pilot were airlifted to nearby Hospital. The pilot remained unhurt while Air Attaché suffered minor bruises. Pakistani envoy is also safe and recovering fast in the hospital. The Air Attaché has resumed his duties in his office.
