

PESHAWAR RUNWAY REPAIR IN FULL SWING

Islamabad 18 May, 2013: Being the joint user of Peshawar runway, Pakistan Air Force is providing all out support to Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) for the repair of Peshawar runway which is in full swing. To maintain high safety standards all kind of flying at Peshawar airfield was suspended at 1320 Hrs except for the heli-borne operations.

It was learnt at about 3:20 pm that a small portion of the Northern end of runway has developed few cracks through fair wear and tear as the runway carpeting has gone a decade old. Immediately all the flying was suspended and runway was declared closed. It is now under repair and the repair work would likely to be completed by tomorrow morning. The runway would be declared open after the inspection and complete satisfaction of the concerned authorities.
