

PAF HOLDS ANNUAL OPERATIONAL REVIEW

ISLAMABAD 28 AUGUST, 2013:- PAF Annual operational Review for the year of 2012 was held at Air Headquarters, Islamabad. The review was presided over by Air Chief Marshal Tahir Rafique Butt, Chief of the Air Staff, Pakistan Air Force and was attended by Principal Staff Officers, Regional Commanders and Field Officers.

Speaking on the occasion, Air Chief Marshal Tahir Rafique Butt, appreciated the overall performance of PAF in year 2012. He stressed on the need to maintain a high state of operational readiness by the PAF to meet the challenges faced by the country. The new inductions in the PAF and the emphasis on realistic training evident by conduct of various Air Exercises undertaken within and outside the country, he said, are tangible steps in that direction. The Air Chief also highlighted the importance of preserving combat potential in the peacetime, which, he said, necessitated a strict observance of Flight Safety tenets.

Earlier, a detailed review of Operational activities of PAF was presented by Air Marshal Sohail Aman, Deputy Chief of the Air Staff (Operations).

The review culminated with award of the certificates and safety trophy to the Base notching overall highest performance score in the safety achievements and contributions.
