AIR CHIEF INAUGURATES THE MONSOON TREE PLANTATION CAMPAIGN

ISLAMABAD 23 August, 2013:- The Tree Plantation Campaign of Pakistan Air Force, for the Monsoon season 2013, was launched at Air Headquarters, Islamabad. Air Chief Marshal Tahir Rafique Butt, Chief of the Air Staff, Pakistan Air Force inaugurated the campaign by planting a sapling. The ceremony was attended by Principal Staff Officers, airmen and civilians of PAF.

The Monsoon plantation campaign is carried out at all PAF Air Bases and is a yearly feature which provides valuable contribution in making the environment pollution free. This year, Pakistan Air Force has planned to plant 200,000 (two lac) saplings during the season, whereas 1,60,000 (one lac sixty thousands) saplings were planted during last year's Monsoon season. Today's inauguration has kick-started the tree plantation campaign for the year 2013 at all PAF Air Bases and installations.
