OMAR, NASIR, TODD AND KARIM REACH THE SEMI FINALS OF PRESIDENT GOLD CUP INTERNATIONAL SQUASH CHAMPIONSHIP

ISLAMABAD 08 NOVEMBER, 2015: The quarter finals of President Gold Cup International Squash Championship-2015 were played at Mushaf Squash Complex, Islamabad today. Omar Abdel Meguid, Nasir Iqbal, Todd Hamity and Karim Al Fathi made it to the semi finals of the Championship.

The first quarter final was a nail biter between Egyptian Omar Abdel Meguid and Farhan Mahboob from Pakistan.
