## **PRIME MINISTERS OF PAKISTAN AND QATAR WITNESS SCINTILLATING AERIAL DISPLAY OF PAF JF-17 THUNDER AND SUPER MUSHSHAK AT DOHA**

**ISLAMABAD 10 FEBRUARY:** Prime Minister of Pakistan Muhammad Nawaz Sharif and His Excellency Prime Minister of Qatar Abdullah bin Nasser bin Khalifa Al Thani, witnessed the scintillating aerial display of PAF JF-17 Thunder and Super Mushshak aircraft at Doha Qatar today. Air Chief Marshal Sohail Aman, Chief of the Air Staff, Pakistan Air Force and Major General (Pilot) Ghanem bin Shaheen Al Ghanem, Chief of General Staff, Qatar Armed Forces were also present at the occasion. Senior government and military officials of both countries also witnessed the aerial display. It was a momentous occasion when PAF JF-17 Thunder and Super Mushshak aircraft presented spectacular aerial display in the skies of Qatar for the first time. Air Chief Marshal Sohail Aman, Chief of the Air Staff, Pakistan Air Force briefed both the dignitaries about the capabilities of these indigenously manufactured aircraft. Both the dignitaries lauded the performance of PAF aircraft and later on met with the PAF contingent. 02 JF-17 Thunder and 02 Super Mushshak aircraft landed at Qatar on 07 February, 2016 for static and aerial display. Prime Minister of Pakistan Muhammad Nawaz Sharif and high power delegation is on official visit to Qatar.

JF-17 Thunder is a combat aircraft jointly developed by Pakistan and China. This light-weight, single-engine, multi-role aircraft can be used for Ground Attack and Air Intercept role. The JF-17 can employ variety of weapons including air-to-air and air-to-surface missiles. The aircraft is equipped with cutting edge avionics and weaponry.

Super Mushshak is being completely manufactured in Pakistan Aeronautical Complex Kamra which has been exported to many friendly countries. These air forces are not only operating this sophisticated trainer aircraft but also get training of its air and ground crew from Pakistan.
