HH SHEIKH TAMIM BIN HAMAD AL THANI, EMIR OF QATAR WITNESSES AERIAL DISPLAY OF JF-17 THUNDER AND SUPER MUSHSHAK AIRCRAFT

ISLAMABAD 12 FEBRUARY, 2016: HH Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani, Emir of Qatar witnessed the spectacular aerial display of PAF JF-17 Thunder and Super Mushshak aircraft at Doha today. JF-17 Thunder is a combat aircraft jointly developed by Pakistan and China. This light-weight, single-engine, multi-role aircraft can be used for Ground Attack and Air Intercept role. The JF-17 can employ variety of weapons including air-to-air and air-to-surface missiles. The aircraft is equipped with cutting edge avionics and weaponry.

Super Mushshak is being completely manufactured in Pakistan Aeronautical Complex Kamra which has been exported to many friendly countries. These air forces are not only operating this sophisticated trainer aircraft but also get training of its air and ground crew from Pakistan.
