## **TWO PAF C-130 AIRLIFT RELIEF GOODS FOR THE FLOOD AFFECTED AREAS OF GILGIT BALTISTAN**

**Islamabad 07April, 2016:-** Two PAF C-130 aircraft carrying relief goods for the flood affected areas of Gilgit Baltistan, landed at Gilgit airport today. PAF is undertaking relief operation on the instructions of Government of Pakistan. The two aircraft from PAF Base, Nur Khan airlifted more than 20000 pounds of relief goods comprising tents, blankets and rope for the flood affectees of Gilgit Baltistan. The recent floods have caused havoc in the region, badly damaging the villages and infrastructure. Karakoram highway is blocked at many places due to land sliding and reaching the stranded people is only possible through aerial route. PAF has always stood shoulder to shoulder with the calamity stricken people of the country and has always played an important role in airlifting relief goods to far off and difficult terrains.
