**A CONTRACT SIGNED BETWEEN PAKISTAN AND NIGERIA  
FOR THE SALE OF SUPER MUSHSHAK**

**ISLAMABAD 21 October, 2016.** Pakistan and Nigeria have signed an agreement for sale of ten Super Mushshak Aircraft to Nigerian Air Force. The contract signing ceremony was held at Abuja(Nigeria), where Air Marshal Iya Ahmed Abdullah and Air Marshal Arshad Malik, Chairman Pakistan Aeronautical Complex (PAC) signed the contract. The contract also includes operational training and technical support & assistance to Nigerian Air Force. Pakistan Air Force would completely establish this facility in the shortest possible time.

This contract would not only open new avenues for export of aviation equipment to foreign countries but also help in generating revenue for the country. The Aircraft is already in service with Saudi Arabia, Oman, Iran and South Africa. The deal further strengthens PAC's status as a world class aviation industry producing the supersonic JF-17 Thunder and Super Mushshak trainer aircraft.
