Islamabad 16 December, 2011: The veteran of 1965 war, Former Commander-in-Chief of Pakistan Air Force, Air Marshal Malik Nur Khan, (Hilal-e-Jurat, Sitara-e-Pakistan and Sitara-e-Quaid-i-Azam) was laid to rest with profound military honours at Tamman, District Chakwal. After burial, the floral wreath on behalf of Chief of the Air Staff was laid by Air Marshal Tahir Rafique Butt, Vice Chief of the Air Staff Pakistan Air Force. The floral wreaths were also laid on behalf of President of Pakistan, Prime Minister, Chairman Joint Chiefs of Staff Committee and Pakistan International Airlines.
